1 **SECTION 1. REAUTHORIZATION OF JOINT COMMITTEE.**

2 Effective from January 3, 2021, the joint committee
3 created by Senate Concurrent Resolution 38 (116th Con-
4 gress), agreed to June 26, 2020, to make the necessary
5 arrangements for the inauguration of the President-elect
6 and the Vice President-elect of the United States, is con-
7 tinued with the same power and authority provided for in
8 that resolution.

9 **SEC. 2. USE OF CAPITOL.**

10 The rotunda and Emancipation Hall of the United
11 States Capitol are authorized to be used on January 10,
12 2021, January 17, 2021, and January 20, 2021 by the
13 joint committee created by Senate Concurrent Resolution
14 38 (116th Congress), agreed to June 26, 2020, in connec-
15 tion with the proceedings and ceremonies conducted for
16 the inauguration of the President-elect and the Vice Presi-
17 dent-elect of the United States.
