## CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

Providing for a conditional adjournment or recess of the Senate and an adjournment of the House of Representatives.

1        *Resolved by the Senate (the House of Representatives*  
2 *concurring)*, That when the Senate recesses or adjourns  
3 on any day from Friday, January 4, 2013, through Mon-  
4 day, January 21, 2013, on a motion offered pursuant to  
5 this concurrent resolution by its Majority Leader or his  
6 designee, it stand recessed or adjourned until 12:00 noon  
7 on Monday, January 21, 2013, or such other time on that  
8 day as may be specified by its Majority Leader or his des-  
9 ignee in the motion to recess or adjourn, or until the time  
10 of any reassembly pursuant to section 2 of this concurrent

1 resolution, whichever occurs first; and that when the  
2 House adjourns on any legislative day from Friday, Janu-  
3 ary 4, 2013, through Saturday, January 5, 2013, on a  
4 motion offered pursuant to this concurrent resolution by  
5 its Majority Leader or his designee, it stand adjourned  
6 until 2:00 p.m. on Monday, January 14, 2013, or until  
7 the time of any reassembly pursuant to section 2 of this  
8 concurrent resolution, whichever occurs first.

9       SEC. 2. The Majority Leader of the Senate and the  
10 Speaker of the House, or their respective designees, acting  
11 jointly after consultation with the Minority Leader of the  
12 Senate and the Minority Leader of the House, shall notify  
13 the Members of the Senate and House, respectively, to re-  
14 assemble at such place and time as they may designate  
15 if, in their opinion, the public interest shall warrant it.
