CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

Establishing the Joint Congressional Committee on Inaugural Ceremonies for the inauguration of the President-elect and Vice President-elect of the United States on January 20, 2025.

1 *Resolved by the Senate (the House of Representatives*
2 *concurring),*

3 **SECTION 1. ESTABLISHMENT OF JOINT COMMITTEE.**

4 There is established a Joint Congressional Committee
5 on Inaugural Ceremonies (in this resolution referred to as
6 the “joint committee”) consisting of 3 Senators and 3
7 Members of the House of Representatives, to be appointed
8 by the President of the Senate and the Speaker of the

1 House of Representatives, respectively. The joint com-
2 mittee is authorized to make the necessary arrangements
3 for the inauguration of the President-elect and Vice Presi-
4 dent-elect of the United States on January 20, 2025.

5 **SEC. 2. SUPPORT OF THE JOINT COMMITTEE.**

6 The joint committee—

7 (1) is authorized to utilize appropriate equip-
8 ment and the services of appropriate personnel of
9 departments and agencies of the Federal Govern-
10 ment, under arrangements between the joint com-
11 mittee and the heads of those departments and
12 agencies, in connection with the inaugural pro-
13 ceedings and ceremonies; and

14 (2) may accept gifts and donations of goods
15 and services to carry out its responsibilities.
