4 **TO PRESENT CONGRESSIONAL GOLD MEDAL**
5 **TO WORLD WAR II MEMBERS OF DOOLITTLE**
6 **TOKYO RAIDERS.**

7 (a) AUTHORIZATION.—Emancipation Hall in the
8 Capitol Visitor Center is authorized to be used on April

1 15, 2015, for a ceremony to present the Congressional
2 Gold Medal to the World War II members of the Doolittle
3 Tokyo Raiders, collectively, in recognition of the military
4 service and exemplary record of the Doolittle Tokyo Raid-
5 ers during World War II.

6 (b) PREPARATIONS.—Physical preparations for the
7 conduct of the ceremony described in subsection (a) shall
8 be carried out in accordance with such conditions as may
9 be prescribed by the Architect of the Capitol.
