JOINT RESOLUTION

To amend the Department of Defense Survivor Benefits Continuing Appropriations Resolution, 2014 to make continuing appropriations for death gratuities and related survivor benefits for survivors of deceased members of the Coast Guard.

1 *Resolved by the Senate and House of Representatives*
2 *of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*
3 SECTION 1. (a) The Department of Defense Survivor
4 Benefits Continuing Appropriations Resolution, 2014 is
5 amended—

1 (1) in the matter preceding section 101, by in-
2 serting “or the Department of Homeland Security”
3 after “the Department of Defense”; and

4 (2) in section 101—

5 (A) by redesignating subsection (b) as sub-
6 section (c);

7 (B) by inserting after subsection (a) the
8 following new subsection (b):

9 “(b) Such amounts as may be necessary, at a rate
10 of operations as provided for fiscal year 2013 in the De-
11 partment of Homeland Security Appropriations Act, 2013
12 (division D of Public Law 113–6) and under the authority
13 and conditions provided in such Act, for the ‘Operating
14 Expenses’ account for continuing the projects and activi-
15 ties specified in paragraphs (1) through (4) of subsection
16 (a) with respect to members of the Coast Guard when not
17 in the service of the Navy that are not otherwise specifi-
18 cally provided for in this joint resolution or the Pay Our
19 Military Act and for which appropriations, funds, or other
20 authority were made available by the Department of
21 Homeland Security Appropriations Act, 2013.”; and

22 (C) in subsection (c), as so redesignated,
23 by inserting “or (b)” after “subsection (a)”.

1 (b) The clause following section 106 of that Joint
2 Resolution is amended by striking “Department of De-
3 fense” and inserting “Armed Forces”.
