## JOINT RESOLUTION

Relating to the disapproval of the proposed sale to the Government of the United Arab Emirates of certain defense articles and services.

1       *Resolved by the Senate and House of Representatives*  
2       *of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*  
3       That the issuance of a letter of offer with respect to any  
4       of the following proposed sales to the Government of the  
5       United Arab Emirates (described in the certification  
6       Transmittal No. 19–37, sent to the Speaker of the House  
7       of Representatives and the chairman of the Committee on  
8       Foreign Relations of the Senate pursuant to section  
9       36(b)(1) of the Arms Export Control Act (22 U.S.C.  
10      2776(b)(1)) on May 6, 2019), is hereby prohibited:

1           (1) The proposed sale of up to four hundred  
2 fifty-two (452) Patriot Advanced Capability 3  
3 (PAC-3) Missiles Segment Enhanced (MSE)  
4 (Transmittal Numbered 19-37).

5           (2) The proposed sale of tools and test equip-  
6 ment, support equipment, publications and technical  
7 documentation, personnel training and training  
8 equipment, spare and repair parts, facility design,  
9 U.S. Government and contractor technical, engineer-  
10 ing, and logistics support services, and other related  
11 elements of logistics, sustainment and program sup-  
12 port (Transmittal Numbered 19-37).
