Mr. PAUL introduced the following joint resolution; which was read twice and referred to the Committee on Foreign Relations

JOINT RESOLUTION

Providing for congressional disapproval of the proposed foreign military sale to the Government of Egypt of certain defense articles and services.

1 *Resolved by the Senate and House of Representatives*
2 *of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*
3 That the following proposed foreign military sale to the
4 Government of Egypt is prohibited:

5 (1) The sale of the following defense articles
6 and services, described in Transmittal No. 21–33,
7 submitted to Congress pursuant to section 36(b)(1)
8 of the Arms Export Control Act (22 U.S.C.
9 2776(b)(1)), and published in the Congressional
10 Record on May 25, 2022:

1 (A) The following Major Defense Equip-
2 ment (MDE): Five thousand (5,000) TOW 2A,
3 Radio Frequency (RF) Missiles, BGM-71E-
4 4B-RF. Seventy (70) TOW 2A, Radio Fre-
5 quency (RF) Missiles, BGM-71E-4B-RF (Fly-
6 to-Buy Lot Acceptance Missiles).

7 (B) The following non-MDE: Missile sup-
8 port equipment; technical manuals/publications;
9 spare parts; tool and test equipment; training;
10 U.S. Government technical and logistical sup-
11 port, contractor technical support, and other as-
12 sociated equipment and services; and other re-
13 lated elements of logistical and program sup-
14 port.
