Mr. PAUL introduced the following joint resolution; which was read twice and referred to the Committee on Foreign Relations

JOINT RESOLUTION

Providing for congressional disapproval of the proposed foreign military sale to the Government of Australia of certain defense articles and services.

1 *Resolved by the Senate and House of Representatives*
2 *of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*
3 That the following proposed foreign military sale to the
4 Government of Australia is prohibited:

5 (1) The sale of the following defense articles
6 and services, described in Transmittal No. 22–27,
7 submitted to Congress pursuant to section 36(b)(1)
8 of the Arms Export Control Act (22 U.S.C.
9 2776(b)(1)), and published in the Congressional
10 Record on June 21, 2022: Up to fifteen (15) AGM–

2 (AARGM) Guidance Sections; up to fifteen (15)
3 AARGM Control Sections; up to fifteen (15) High
4 Speed Anti Radiation Missiles (HARM) Rocket Mo-
5 tors; up to fifteen (15) HARM Warheads; and up to
6 fifteen (15) HARM Control Sections. Also included
7 are AGM-88E2 AARGM All Up Round (AUR) tac-
8 tical missiles; AGM-88E2 AARGM Captive Air
9 Training Missile (CATM); HARM G-Code AUR;
10 HARM G-Code CATM; M-Code GPS receivers; con-
11 tainers; support and test equipment; EA-18G
12 Growler test support; spare and repair parts; soft-
13 ware (Classified and Unclassified); U.S. Government
14 and contractor engineering support; and other re-
15 lated elements of logistical and program support.
