Mr. PAUL introduced the following joint resolution; which was read twice and referred to the Committee on Foreign Relations

JOINT RESOLUTION

Providing for congressional disapproval of the proposed foreign military sale to the Kingdom of Saudi Arabia of certain defense articles and services.

1 *Resolved by the Senate and House of Representatives*
2 *of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*
3 That the following proposed foreign military sale to the
4 Kingdom of Saudi Arabia is prohibited:

5 (1) The sale of the following defense articles
6 and services, described in Transmittal No. 23–15,
7 submitted to Congress pursuant to section 36(b)(1)
8 of the Arms Export Control Act (22 U.S.C.
9 2776(b)(1)), and published in the Congressional
10 Record on December 7, 2023: seven Embedded

1 Global Positioning System/Inertial Navigation Sys-
2 tem (GPS/INS) (EGI) security devices, Airborne,
3 with Selective Availability Anti-Spoofing Module
4 (SAASM) or M-Code capability, and five (5)
5 L3Harris BlackRock Communications Intelligence
6 Sensor Suites. Also included are KY-100M
7 narrowband/wideband secure communications termi-
8 nals; KIV-77 MODE 4/5 Identification Friend or
9 Foe (IFF) cryptographic appliques; AN/PYQ-10
10 Simple Key Loaders; integrated electronic intel-
11 ligence (ELINT)/signals intelligence (SIGINT) sys-
12 tems; L-3 Communication Systems-West (CSW)
13 multiband receivers/transmitters; ARC-210 radios;
14 high frequency (HF) radios; secure communications
15 equipment; precision navigation and cryptographic
16 devices; aircraft support and support equipment; test
17 and integration support; equipment; spare and re-
18 pair parts; consumables and accessories; repair and
19 return support; U.S. Government and contractor en-
20 gineering, technical, and logistics support services;
21 studies and surveys; and other related elements of
22 logistics and program support.
