JOINT RESOLUTION

Providing for congressional disapproval of the proposed foreign military sales to the Government of Egypt of certain defense articles and services.

3 That the following proposed foreign military sales to the
4 Government of Egypt are prohibited:

5 (1) The sale of the following defense articles
6 and services, described in Transmittal No. 22–58,
7 submitted to Congress pursuant to section 36(b)(1)
8 of the Arms Export Control Act (22 U.S.C.
9 2776(b)(1)), and published in the Congressional

1 Record on January 10, 2024: 28-Meter Patrol Craft
2 Kits and related equipment.

3 (2) The sale of the following defense articles
4 and services, described in Transmittal No. 22-54,
5 submitted to Congress pursuant to section 36(b)(1)
6 of the Arms Export Control Act (22 U.S.C.
7 2776(b)(1)), and published in the Congressional
8 Record on January 10, 2024: Light Tactical Vehicle
9 Chassis and Fleet Build and related equipment.
