JOINT RESOLUTION

Providing for congressional disapproval of the proposed foreign military sale to the Kingdom of Saudi Arabia of certain defense articles and services.

1 *Resolved by the Senate and House of Representatives*
2 *of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*
3 That the following proposed foreign military sale to the
4 Kingdom of Saudi Arabia is prohibited:

5 (1) The sale of the following defense articles
6 and services, described in Transmittal No. 22–26,
7 submitted to Congress pursuant to section 36(b)(1)
8 of the Arms Export Control Act (22 U.S.C.
9 2776(b)(1)), and published in the Congressional
10 Record on August 2, 2022: three hundred (300) PA-

2 Tactical Ballistic missiles (GEM-T); tools and test
3 equipment; range and test programs; support equip-
4 ment to include associated publications and technical
5 documentation; training equipment; spare and repair
6 parts; New Equipment Training; Transportation;
7 Quality Assurance Team support; U.S. Government
8 and contractor technical assistance; engineering, and
9 logistics support services; Systems Integration and
10 Checkout (SICO); field office support; International
11 Engineering Services Program Field Surveillance
12 Program; and other related elements of logistics and
13 program support.

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
