To authorize representation by the Senate Legal Counsel

Whereas, Senator Mitch McConnell, Vice President Joseph R.
Biden, Jr., and Sergeant at Arms Terrance W. Gainer
have been named as defendants in the case of Steve
Schonberg v. Senator Mitch McConnell, et al., No. 3:13-
cv-220, now pending in the United States District Court
for the Western District of Kentucky;

Whereas, pursuant to sections 703(a) and 704(a)(1) of the
Ethics in Government Act of 1978, 2 U.S.C. §§ 288b(a)
and 288c(a)(1), the Senate may direct its counsel to de-
fend Members and officers of the Senate in civil actions
relating to their official responsibilities: Now, therefore,
be it
