## RESOLUTION

Requiring that legislation considered by the Senate to be confined to a single issue.

1 Resolved,

2 SECTION 1. SINGLE-ISSUE REQUIREMENT.

3 (a) POINT OF ORDER.—It shall not be in order in
4 the Senate to consider a bill or resolution that is not con5 fined to a single subject.

6 (b) SUPERMAJORITY WAIVER AND APPEALS.—

7 (1) WAIVER.—This section may be waived or
8 suspended in the Senate only by the affirmative vote
9 of two-thirds of the Members, duly chosen and
10 sworn.

(2) APPEALS.—Appeals in the Senate from the 1 2 decisions of the Chair relating to any provision of 3 this section shall be limited to 30 minutes, to be 4 equally divided between, and controlled by, the appellant and the manager of the bill or joint resolu-5 6 tion. An affirmative vote of two-thirds of the Mem-7 bers of the Senate, duly chosen and sworn, shall be required to sustain an appeal of the ruling of the 8 9 Chair on a point of order raised under this section.
