Authorizing expenditures by the Senate Committee on Indian Affairs.

IN THE SENATE OF THE UNITED STATES

FEBRUARY 26, 2013

Ms. CANTWELL, from the Committee on Indian Affairs, reported the following original resolution; which was referred to the Committee on Rules and Administration

RESOLUTION

Authorizing expenditures by the Senate Committee on Indian Affairs.

1 *Resolved*, That, in carrying out its powers, duties and
2 functions imposed by section 105 of S. Res. 4, agreed to
3 February 4, 1977 (95th Congress), and in exercising the
4 authority conferred on it by that section, the Committee
5 on Indian Affairs is authorized from March 1, 2013,
6 through September 30, 2013, in its discretion (1) to make
7 expenditures from the contingent fund of the Senate, (2)
8 to employ personnel, and (3) with the prior consent of the
9 Government department or agency concerned and the
10 Committee on Rules and Administration, to use on a reim-

1 bursable, or non-reimbursable, basis the services of per-
2 sonnel of any such department or agency.

3 SEC. 2. (a) The expenses of the committee for the
4 period March 1, 2013, through September 30, 2013,
5 under this resolution shall not exceed \$1,304,696.00, of
6 which amount (1) not to exceed \$20,000 may be expended
7 for the procurement of the services of individual consult-
8 ants, or organizations thereof (as authorized by section
9 202(i) of the Legislative Reorganization Act of 1946, as
10 amended), and (2) not to exceed \$20,000 may be expended
11 for the training of professional staff of committee (under
12 procedures specified by section 202(j) of the Legislative
13 Reorganization Act of 1946).

14 SEC. 3. The committee shall report its findings, to-
15 gether with such recommendations for legislation as it
16 deems advisable, to the Senate at the earliest practicable
17 date, but not later than February 28, 2015.

18 SEC. 4. Expenses of the committee under this resolu-
19 tion shall be paid from the contingent fund of the Senate
20 upon vouchers approved by the Chairwoman of the com-
21 mittee, except that vouchers shall not be required (1) for
22 the disbursement of the salaries of employees paid at an
23 annual rate, or (2) for the payment of telecommunications
24 provided by the Office of the Sergeant at Arms and Door-
25 keeper, United States Senate, (3) for the payment of sta-

1 tionery supplies purchased through the Keeper of the Sta-
2 tionery, United States Senate, or (4) for payments to the
3 Postmaster, United States Senate, or (5) for the payment
4 of metered charges on copying equipment provided by the
5 Office of the Sergeant at Arms and Doorkeeper, United
6 States Senate, or (6) for the payment of Senate Recording
7 and Photographic Services, or (7) for payment of franked
8 and mass mail costs by the Sergeant at Arms and Door-
9 keeper, United States Senate.

10 SEC. 5. There are authorized such sums as may be
11 necessary for agency contributions related to the com-
12 pensation of employees of the committee from March 1,
13 2013, through September 30, 2013, to be paid from the
14 Appropriations account for Expenses of Inquiries and In-
15 vestigations.

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
