## RESOLUTION

Authorizing the Sergeant at Arms and Doorkeeper of the Senate to conduct quarterly blood donation drives.

1       *Resolved,*

2       **SECTION 1. QUARTERLY SENATE BLOOD DONATION**

3                       **DRIVES.**

4               (a) AUTHORIZATION.—

5                       (1) IN GENERAL.—During calendar year 2024,  
6               the Sergeant at Arms and Doorkeeper of the Senate  
7               (referred to in this resolution as the “Sergeant at  
8               Arms”) is authorized to conduct a blood donation  
9               drive once every quarter, in accordance with para-  
10              graphs (2) and (3).

1           (2) DATE SELECTION.—The Sergeant at Arms  
2 shall, in consultation with the Committee on Rules  
3 and Administration of the Senate, select the date for  
4 each drive conducted under paragraph (1).

5           (3) SELECTION OF LOCATIONS AND  
6 PARTNERING BLOOD DONATION ORGANIZATIONS.—

7           (A) IN GENERAL.—The Sergeant at Arms  
8 shall identify and, with the approval of the  
9 Committee on Rules and Administration of the  
10 Senate, select a location and a partnering blood  
11 donation organization for each drive conducted  
12 under paragraph (1).

13           (B) MEMBER REQUESTS.—In identifying  
14 appropriate partnering blood donation organiza-  
15 tions under subparagraph (A), the Sergeant at  
16 Arms may consider a request from a Senator  
17 for a specific blood donation organization.

18           (b) IMPLEMENTATION.—Physical preparations for  
19 the conduct of, and the implementation of, each drive au-  
20 thorized under subsection (a)(1) shall be carried out in  
21 accordance with such conditions as the Sergeant at Arms,  
22 in consultation with the Committee on Rules and Adminis-  
23 tration of the Senate, may prescribe.
