## RESOLUTION

Designating the month of June 2018 as “Immigrant  
Heritage Month”.

Whereas the United States has a rich history because the  
United States has always been a country of immigrants;

Whereas the diverse heritage of the United States is one of  
the defining aspects of the country’s success story;

Whereas generations of immigrants from every corner of the  
globe have helped build the economy of the United States  
and created the unique character of the country;

Whereas the United States has long served as a melting pot  
of cultural diversity;

Whereas immigrants continue to grow businesses, innovate,  
strengthen the economy, and create jobs for people in the  
United States; and

Whereas many immigrants are entrepreneurs and business owners: Now, therefore, be it

1       *Resolved*, That the Senate—

2               (1) designates June 2018 as “Immigrant Herit-  
3       age Month”;

4               (2) recognizes the significance of Immigrant  
5       Heritage Month as an important time to celebrate  
6       the contributions of immigrants to the history of the  
7       United States; and

8               (3) urges the people of the United States to ob-  
9       serve Immigrant Heritage Month with appropriate  
10       programs and activities.
