Mr. MERKLEY submitted the following resolution; which was referred to the Committee on Rules and Administration

RESOLUTION

Modifying extended debate in the Senate to improve the legislative process.

1 Resolved,

2 SECTION 1. EXTENDED DEBATE.

3 Paragraph 2 of rule XXII of the Standing Rules of
4 the Senate is amended by striking the second undesig5 nated paragraph and inserting the following:

6 "'Is it the sense of the Senate that the debate shall 7 be brought to a close?' And unless that question shall be 8 decided in the negative by one more than two-fifths of the 9 Senators duly chosen and sworn (except on a measure or 10 motion to amend the Senate rules, in which case the nec-11 essary vote shall be two-thirds of the Senators present and voting in the affirmative, a quorum being present), then
 cloture has been invoked.

3 "If that question is on disposition of a bill or joint 4 resolution, a resolution or concurrent resolution, a sub-5 stitute amendment for a bill or resolution, a motion with respect to amendments between the Houses, a conference 6 7 report, or advice and consent to a nomination or treaty, 8 and if such question shall be decided in the affirmative 9 by a majority of Senators voting, a quorum being present, 10 and in the negative by more than two-fifths of the Senators duly chosen and sworn (or in the affirmative by less 11 12 than two-thirds of the Senators voting, a quorum being 13 present, in the case of a measure or motion to amend the Senate rules), then it shall be in order for the Majority 14 15 Leader (or his or her designee) to initiate a period of extended debate upon the measure, motion, or other matter 16 pending before the Senate, or the unfinished business, in 17 relation to which the motion to close debate was offered, 18 in which case the period of extended debate shall begin 19 20 one hour later.

"During a period of extended debate, such measure,
motion, or other matter pending before the Senate, or the
unfinished business, shall be the unfinished business to the
exclusion of all other business, except on action or motion
by the Majority Leader (or his or her designee).

1 "During a period of extended debate it shall not be 2 in order for a Senator other than the Majority Leader (or 3 his or her designee) to raise a question as to the presence 4 of a quorum, except immediately prior to a vote or when 5 it has been more than forty-eight hours since a quorum was demonstrated. If upon a roll call it shall be ascer-6 7 tained that a quorum is not present, then the Senate shall 8 adjourn to a time previously decided by order of the Sen-9 ate or, if no such time has been established, then to a 10 time certain determined by the Majority Leader, after consultation with the Minority Leader. 11

12 "During a period of extended debate a motion to ad-13 journ or recess shall not be in order, unless made by the 14 Majority Leader (or his or her designee) or if the absence 15 of a quorum has been demonstrated. Notwithstanding 16 paragraph 1 of rule XIX, there shall be no limit to the 17 number of times a Senator may speak upon any question 18 during a period of extended debate.

''If, during the course of extended debate, the Presiding Officer puts any question to a vote, the Majority Leader (or his or her designee) may postpone any such vote, which shall occur at a time determined by the Majority Leader, after consultation with the Minority Leader, but not later than the time at which a quorum is next demonstrated.

1 "If at any time during a period of extended debate 2 no Senator seeks recognition, then the Presiding Officer 3 shall inquire as to whether any Senator seeks recognition. 4 If no Senator seeks recognition, then the Presiding Officer 5 shall again put the question as to bringing debate to a close (and the Majority Leader or his or her designee may 6 7 postpone such vote in accordance with the preceding para-8 graph), which shall be decided without further debate or 9 intervening motion. If that question shall be decided in 10 the affirmative by a majority of Senators voting, a quorum being present, then cloture has been invoked and the pe-11 12 riod of extended debate has ended. If that question shall 13 be decided in the negative by a majority of Senators voting, a quorum being present, then the period of extended 14 15 debate has ended.

16 "If cloture is invoked, then the measure, motion, 17 other matter pending before the Senate, or the unfinished 18 business, in relation to which the motion to close debate 19 was offered, shall remain the unfinished business to the 20 exclusion of all other business until disposed of.".
