RESOLUTION

Authorizing the Sergeant at Arms and Doorkeeper of the Senate to conduct quarterly blood donation drives.

1 *Resolved,*

2 **SECTION 1. QUARTERLY SENATE BLOOD DONATION**

3 **DRIVES.**

4 (a) AUTHORIZATION.—

5 (1) IN GENERAL.—During calendar year 2023,

6 the Sergeant at Arms and Doorkeeper of the Senate,

7 in conjunction with a partnering blood donation or-

8 ganization, is authorized to conduct a blood donation

9 drive once every quarter in room G-50 of the Ever-

10 ett McKinley Dirksen Senate Office Building.

1 (2) DATE SELECTION.—The Sergeant at Arms
2 and Doorkeeper of the Senate shall, in consultation
3 with the Committee on Rules and Administration of
4 the Senate—

5 (A) identify the dates for quarterly blood
6 donation drives conducted under paragraph (1);
7 and

8 (B) select the partnering blood donation
9 organization for each such drive.

10 (b) IMPLEMENTATION.—Physical preparations for
11 the conduct of, and the implementation of, each blood do-
12 nation drive authorized under subsection (a) shall be car-
13 ried out in accordance with such conditions as the Ser-
14 geant at Arms and Doorkeeper of the Senate, in consulta-
15 tion with the Committee on Rules and Administration of
16 the Senate, may prescribe.
