LEAD EXPOSURE EDUCATION AND TESTING AMENDMENTS

Representative **Stewart E. Barlow** proposes the following amendments: 1. Page 1, Lines 15 through 16: 15 for lead exposure in children {; and} 16 ← creates a restricted account to fund the activities of the program created in this bill. } *Page 2, Line 28:* 28 (1) $\{\frac{a}{a}\}$ The department shall establish $\{\frac{a}{a}\}$ a child blood lead epidemiology and surveillance program to: (a) encourage pediatric health care providers to include a lead test in accordance with the department's recommendations under Subsection (2); and (b) conduct a public education program to Page 2, Lines 33 through 35: 33 {-(b)-} The department may recommend consideration of screening and testing during the 34 first year or second year well child clinical visit. 35 {-(2)-} (3) (a) The department shall provide the information described in Subsection (1) to Page 2, Line 52 through Page 3, Line 63: 52 children for lead exposure; {-and-} (viii) a local health department as defined in Section 26A-1-102; and 53 (ix) any other person that the department believes would advance public education {(viii)} 54 regarding the effects of lead exposure on children. (4) The department shall seek grant funding to fund the program created in this section. {-55- (3) (a) There is created a restricted account within the General Fund known as the "Childhood Lead Testing Prevention and Education Restricted Account." **56** 57 (b) The restricted account consists of: 58 (i) money appropriated to the restricted account by the Legislature; **59** (ii) private donations; and (iii) all income and interest derived from the deposit and investment of money in the 60 **61** account.

(c) Subject to legislative appropriations, money in the restricted account may be used

to fund activities related to the program created in this section.
