Representative Raymond P. Ward proposes the following amendments:

- 1. Page 8, Line 215:
 - 215 cause of death can be ascertained without an autopsy being performed.
 - (c) If the deceased chose not to be seen or treated by a health care professional for a spiritual or religious reason, a district attorney, county attorney, or law enforcement agency, may not request an autopsy or inquest under Subsection (3)(a) solely because of the deceased's choice.
- 2. Page 8, Lines 216 through 218:
 - 216 (d) The medical examiner or medical examiner's designee may not conduct a requested
 - 217 autopsy described in Subsection (3)(a) if the medical examiner or medical examiner's designee
 - 218 <u>determines</u> :
 - (i) the request violates Subsection (3)(c); or
 - (ii) the cause of death can be determined without performing an autopsy.
