Enactment of this legislation could increase dedicated credits revenue collected by the Department of Workforce Services (DWS) by \$2.400 per year beginning in FY 2020 from a change in the civil penalty for Child Care fraud overpayment from 10% to 50% of the overpayment amount.

Enactment of this legislation should not impact overall state expenditures but would move \$159,000 in General Fund Safety Net Initiative money from the DWS to the Division of Substance Abuse and Mental Health in the Department of Human Services (DHS) beginning in FY 2021.
