Enactment of this legislation could cost \$60,700 ongoing beginning in FY 2019. Of that amount, \$6,400 in General Fund and \$800 in federal funds is for personnel at the Department of Human Services - Division of Child and Family Services to determine whether a parent or guardian has an outstanding felony arrest warrant. The remaining \$53,500 in General Fund is for personnel at the Office of the Attorney General - Child Protection Division to prepare and file reports with the court.
