## Local Government

UCA 36-12-13(2)(c)
Enactment of this legislation may cost 12 of 13 local health departments around $\$ 1,000$ to create and disseminate an informational notice to cosmetology facilities and may result in local health departments fining cosmetology facilities up to $\$ 500$ for not posting required notices.

## Individuals \& Businesses

UCA 36-12-13(2)(c)
Cosmetology facilities may pay up to $\$ 500$ for not posting required notices.

## Regulatory Impact

UCA 36-12-13(2)(d)
Enactment of this legislation could result in a small increase in the regulatory burden for Utah residents or businesses.
