State Government

UCA 36-12-13(2)(b)

This bill could transfer \$93,700 ongoing beginning in FY 2019 from the General Fund to the Indigent Defense Resources Restricted Account.

Beginning in FY 2019, this bill could transfer \$93,700 ongoing from the General Fund to the Indigent Defense Resources Restricted Account. This bill could cost up to \$93,700 ongoing from the Indigent Defense Resources Restricted Account for increased legal services grants in certain cases.

Local Government

UCA 36-12-13(2)(c)

Upon meeting certain conditions, county governments under this bill could receive \$93,700 ongoing in additional funding for supplementing county legal defense services for the indigent in certain cases beginning in FY 2019.

Individuals & Businesses

UCA 36-12-13(2)(d)

Indigent parents may receive state-paid appointed counsel in some parental rights cases.

Regulatory Impact

UCA 36-12-13(2)(e)

Enactment of this legislation likely will not change the regulatory burden for Utah residents or businesses.

Notes on Notes
