	(a) "Mountain daylight time" means the period during a year when mountain standard
ti	ime is advanced one hour according to the provisions of 15 U.S.C. Sec. 260a.

30	(2) The state of Utah exempts all areas of the state from standard time.

33	Section 2. Contingent effective date.
34	(1) This bill takes effect on the first Sunday of November following the day on which
