LONG TITLE

General Description:

This bill provides for the regulation of explosives use by a mining operation that blasts within ~~one~~ one-half mile of a residential structure.

Highlighted Provisions:

This bill:

▸ requires a mining operation that blasts within ~~one~~ one-half mile of a residential structure to

comply with local, state, and federal law;

▸ grants rulemaking authority to the Board of Oil, Gas, and Mining to regulate a mining operation that blasts within ~~one~~ one-half mile of a residential structure; and

▸ grants rulemaking authority to the Board of Oil, Gas, and Mining to make rules, ~~in order to prevent injury or damage, that impose further, specific limitations on a~~ for a

blasting mining operation that blasts within ~~one~~ one-half mile of a residential structure ~~that address certain considerations.~~

28 *Be it enacted by the Legislature of the state of Utah:*

29 Section 1. Section **40-8-24** is enacted to read:

30 **40-8-24. Regulation of blasting near a residential structure.**
