29	Section 1. Section <b>76-2-310</b> is enacted to read:
30	76-2-310. Limitation on defense based on victim's sexual orientation or gender

32	(1) As used in this section:
33	(a) "Gender identity" means the actual or perceived gender-related identity, expression,
34	appearance, behavior, or other gender-related characteristic of an individual, regardless of the
35	individual's physiology or assigned sex at birth.
36	(b) "Sexual orientation" means an individual's actual or perceived enduring pattern of
37	emotional, romantic, or sexual attraction to men, women, or both.
38	(2) An actor may not use the actor's perception or misperception of a victim's sexual
39	orientation or gender identity, including the actor's perception or misperception of a nonviolent
40	romantic or sexual advance made by a victim toward the actor:
41	(a) to defend, excuse, or justify the actor's conduct in committing a criminal offense; or
42	(b) to mitigate the severity of or sentence for the actor's criminal offense.
43	Section 2. Effective date.
44	This bill takes effect on May 1, 2024
