30 two-year renewal cycle established by rule. 31 (b) The division may by renewal extend or shorten a license expiration date by as much 32 as one year to stagger the renewal cycles it administers. 33 (2) Each license automatically expires on the expiration date shown on the license 34 unless renewed by the licensee in accordance with Section 58-1-308. 35 (3) Each person holding a current license issued under this chapter shall complete in 36 each period of licensure a program of qualifying continuing professional education in accordance with standards defined by division rule made in accordance with Title 63G, Chapter 37
