LONG TITLE

General Description:

This bill amends provisions relating to codes affecting buildings.

Highlighted Provisions:

This bill:

▶ updates the version of the National Electrical Code ~~H→~~ and the Utah Wildland Urban

Interface Code ~~←H~~ adopted by the state;

▶ reinstates a chapter of the International Building Code, as it applies to the state, relating to residential energy efficiency, and deletes provisions that replaced that chapter; ~~H→~~ [and]

▶ prohibits the state and political subdivisions of the state from adopting any version of the International Green Construction Code; and ~~←H~~

▶ modifies provisions of the International Energy Conservation Code, as it applies to the state, relating to:

- ratings of windows, doors, and skylights; and
- the inspection of buildings for air leakage.

35 incorporated by reference, and together with the amendments specified in Chapters 3 and 4, are
36 the construction standards to be applied to building construction, alteration, remodeling, and
37 repair, and in the regulation of building construction, alteration, remodeling, and repair in the
