Section 1. Section 78A-6-516 is enacted to read:
78A-6-516. Visitation rights of grandparents.
(1) As used in this section, "relative" means an individual related to the grandchild by
blood or marriage as:
(a) a sibling;

29	(c) an uncle; or
30	(d) a grandparent.
31	(2) The standing and visitation rights of a grandparent under Section 30-5-2 continue
32	and are not extinguished when a parent's rights are terminated under this part and when there
33	has been an adoption of the child by a relative.
34	(3) An individual may file a one-time petition under this section for determination of
35	grandparent visitation rights in the same manner and to the same extent as provided in Section
36	30-5-2, subject to the same applicable standards and consideration of a child's and family's best
37	interest.
