	(1) The governor, an executive agency, or a political subdivision may not execute an
<u>a</u>	agreement to sell, exchange, or transfer 500 or more acres of state land, regardless of whether
<u>t</u>	the 500 acres are contiguous or noncontiguous, until:
	(a) the governor, executive agency, or political subdivision submits the agreement or
ľ	proposed agreement to the Legislature for its approval or rejection; and
	(b) the Legislature passes a joint resolution approving an agreement or proposed
<u>a</u>	agreement.
	(2) The governor, an executive agency, or a political subdivision shall notify the
1	Natural Resources, Agriculture, and Environment Interim Committee before executing an
<u>a</u>	agreement to sell, exchange, or transfer less than 500 acres of state land.
	(3) A political subdivision shall give written notice to the Legislative Management
<u>(</u>	Committee as soon as the political subdivision enters into a discussion with a federal agent or
e	entity regarding land management issues within the state.
