	The university is authorized to receive gifts, contributions, and donations of all kinds,
<u>for</u>	the development, operation, or support of the school.
	Section 4. Section 53B-29-304 is enacted to read:
	53B-29-304. Reporting requirement.
	(1) Beginning October 1, 2022, and on or before each October 1 thereafter, the

59	university shall report to the Education Interim Committee about the operation of the school.
