Section 1. Section 73-2-4 is amended to read:	
73-2-4. Deputies and assistants Employment	and salaries Purchase of
equipment and supplies.	
For the purpose of performing the duties of [his] the state engineer's office the state	
engineer may:	
(1) employ [a deputy and all] one or more deputies and necessary assistants;	
(2) fix division employees' salaries in accordance with salary standards [adopted by the	
Division of Finance] under Title 63A, Chapter 17, Utah State Personnel Management Act; and	
(3) purchase [all] necessary equipment and supplies.
