31	[No municipal corporation, shall directly or indirectly, lease, sell, alien or dispose of
32	any waterworks, water rights, or sources of water supply now, or hereafter to be owned or
33	controlled by it; but all such waterworks, water rights and sources of water supply now owned
34	or hereafter to be acquired by any municipal corporation, shall be preserved, maintained and
35	operated by it for supplying its inhabitants with water at reasonable charges: Provided, That
36	nothing herein contained shall be construed to prevent any such municipal corporation from
37	exchanging water-rights, or sources of water supply, for other water-rights or sources of water

39	(1) A municipality that owns, acquires, or controls water rights or sources of water
