- 31 (2) It is intended that an institution of higher education allow Utah residents who have
- 32 reached 62 years of age <u>or are veterans as defined in Section 68-3-12.5</u> to enroll at the
- 33 institution, in classes for which they may be qualified, on the basis of surplus space in regularly
- 34 scheduled classes and in accordance with this chapter and implementing rules. These persons
- 35 are exempt from tuition and other charges, except for a quarterly registration fee established by
- 36 the board.
