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| Be it enacted by the Legislature of the state of Utah: |
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| Section 1. Section 53F-2-524 is enacted to read: |
| 53F-2-524. Salary supplement for certified athletic directors. |
| (1) As used in this section: |
| (a) "Athletic administrator certification" means a current athletic administrator |
| certificate issued by the National Interscholastic Athletic Administrators Association. |
| (b) "Athletic director" means an LEA employee whose primary duty is to supervise the |
| administration of athletic activities in a public school in grades 10, 11, or 12. |
| (c) "Certified athletic director" means an athletic director who holds an athletic |
| administrator certification. |
| (d) "Certified master athletic director" means an athletic director who holds a master |
| athletic administrator certification. |
| (e) "Master athletic administrator certification" means a current master athletic |
| administrator certificate issued by the National Interscholastic Athletic Administrators |
| Association. |
| (f) "Salary supplement" means a salary supplement for a certified athletic director or |
| certified master athletic director described in this section. |
| (2) (a) Subject to future budget constraints, the Legislature shall: |
| (i) annually appropriate money to maintain annual salary supplements provided in |
| previous years; and |
| (ii) provide salary supplements to new recipients. |
| (b) Money appropriated for salary supplements shall include money for the following |
| employer-paid benefits: |
| (i) retirement; |
| (ii) workers' compensation; |
| (iii) Social Security; and |
| (iv) Medicare. |
| (3) (a) The annual salary supplement for a certified athletic director is \$2,500. |
| (b) The annual salary supplement for a certified master athletic director is \$5,000. |
| (c) An athletic director who qualifies for a salary supplement under Subsections (3)(a) |
