28	(1) An applicant for licensure as a clinical mental health counselor shall:
29	(a) submit an application on a form provided by the division;
30	(b) pay a fee determined by the department under Section 63J-1-504;
31	(c) be of good moral character;
32	(d) produce certified transcripts from an accredited institution of higher education
33	recognized by the division in collaboration with the board verifying satisfactory completion of:
34	(i) an education and degree in an education program in counseling, including

36	58-1-203 preparing one to competently engage in mental health therapy; and
37	(ii) an earned doctoral or master's degree resulting from that education program;
