30	Section 1. Section 26-18-21 is enacted to read:
31	26-18-21. Medical eligibility expansion.
32	(1) For purposes of this section, "PPACA" means the same as that term is defined in
33	Section 31A-1-301.
34	(2) The state shall, in accordance with this section and PPACA, amend its state
35	Medicaid plan to expand Medicaid eligibility to the optional Medicaid expansion population
36	under PPACA.
37	(3) The Medicaid expansion under this section is repealed on the date of a certification
38	by the executive director that:
39	(a) Congress has taken an action that will reduce the federal financial participation for
40	the expansion population; and
41	(b) the reduction in federal financial participation exceeds the reductions described in
42	PPACA, Subsection 2001(a)(3).
43	Section 2. Repealer.

45	Section 26-18-18, Optional Medicaid expansion.
