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| 29 | (a) "LEA data system" or "LEA's data system" means a data system that:                          |
| 30 | (i) is developed, selected, or relied upon by an LEA; and                                       |
| 31 | (ii) the LEA uses to collect data or submit data to the state board related to:                 |
| 32 | (A) student information;  |
| 33 | (B) educator information;   |
| 34 | (C) financial information; or   |
| 35 | (D) other information requested by the state board.   |
| 36 | (b) "LEA financial information system" or "LEA's financial information system" means            |
