General Description:		
This bill modifies the offenses of human smuggling, aggravated human smuggling, and		
aggravated human trafficking.		
Highlighted Provisions:		
This bill:		
<ul> <li>increases the penalty for human smuggling from a third degree felony to a second</li> </ul>		
degree felony;		
<ul> <li>increases the penalty for aggravated human smuggling from a second degree felony</li> </ul>		
to a first degree felony; and		
<ul> <li>removes the requirement of "in a single episode" when there are 10 or more victims</li> </ul>		
from the offenses of aggravated human smuggling and aggravated human		
trafficking.

32	(1) Human trafficking for labor and human trafficking for sexual exploitation are each
33	a second degree felony, except under Section 76-5-310.
34	(2) Human smuggling under Section 76-5-308 of one or more persons is a [third]
35	second degree felony, except under Section 76-5-310.
36	(3) Human trafficking for labor or for sexual exploitation, human trafficking of a child,
37	and human smuggling are each a separate offense from any other crime committed in
