LONG TITLE

General Description:

This bill increases certain minimum motor vehicle insurance coverage limits.

Highlighted Provisions:

This bill:

- ▶ increases the minimum motor vehicle insurance coverage limit:
 - from \$15,000 to \$50,000 for property damage in an accident; and
 - from \$80,000 to \$100,000 in any one accident whether arising from bodily injury or death of others, or from property damage.

AMENDS:

31A-22-304, as last amended by Laws of Utah 2008, Chapter 371

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the state of Utah:

Section 1. Section **31A-22-304** is amended to read:

31A-22-304. Motor vehicle liability policy minimum limits.

Policies containing motor vehicle liability coverage may not limit the insurer's liability



28 under that coverage below the following:

29 (1) (a) \$25,000 because of liability for bodily injury to or death of one person, arising
30 out of the use of a motor vehicle in any one accident;

31 (b) subject to the limit for one person in Subsection (1)(a), in the amount of \$65,000
32 because of liability for bodily injury to or death of two or more persons arising out of the use of
33 a motor vehicle in any one accident; and

34 (c) in the amount of [~~\$15,000~~] \$50,000 because of liability for injury to, or destruction
35 of, property of others arising out of the use of a motor vehicle in any one accident; or

36 (2) [~~\$80,000~~] \$100,000 in any one accident whether arising from bodily injury to or the
37 death of others, or from destruction of, or damage to, the property of others.
