LONG TITLE

General Description:

This bill modifies the Certified Public Accountant Licensing Act.

Highlighted Provisions:

This bill:

► modifies the requirements for taking the qualifying examinations that are necessary for an applicant to obtain licensure as a certified public accountant by requiring:

- completion of at least 135 semester hours or 200 quarter hours of the education requirement for licensure as a certified public accountant; and
- approval by the board, or an organization approved by the board, to take the examinations.

58-26a-306, as last amended by Laws of Utah 2009, Chapter 183

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the state of Utah:

Section 1. Section **58-26a-306** is amended to read:

58-26a-306. Examination requirements.

- 30 (1) Before taking the qualifying examinations, an applicant shall:
- 31 (a) submit an application in a form approved by the division;
- 32 (b) pay a fee determined by the department under Section 63J-1-504;
- 33 (c) demonstrate completion of at least 135 semester hours or 200 quarter hours of the
- 34 education requirement described in Subsection 58-26a-302(1)(d); and
- 35 (d) be approved by the board, or an organization designated by the board, to take the
- 36 qualifying examinations.
- 37 (2) A person must sit for and meet the conditioning requirements of the AICPA
- 38 Uniform CPA Examination as established by the AICPA.
