26	Section 1. Section <b>9-11-104</b> is amended to read:
27	9-11-104. San Juan Navajo Revitalization Fund.
28	(1) (a) There is created a restricted special revenue fund called the "Navajo
29	Revitalization Fund."

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(b) The revitalization fund shall consist of:

(i) [monies] money deposited to the revitalization fund under this chapter;

(ii) [monies] money deposited to the revitalization fund under Section 59-5-119; and

(iii) any loan repayment or interest on a loan issued under this chapter.

(2) (a) The revitalization fund shall earn interest.

(b) [All] The interest earned on revitalization fund [monies] money shall be deposited

- 37 (3) [Any] The unallocated balance in the <u>revitalization</u> fund at the end of a fiscal year 38 [shall be] is nonlapsing.
