Section 1. Section **62A-2-129** is enacted to read:

28	62A-2-129. Licensed Provider Assessment Fund Creation Deposits Uses.
29	(1) There is created an expendable special revenue fund known as the "Licensed
30	Provider Assessment Fund" consisting of:
31	(a) the assessments collected under, and any interest and penalties levied with the
32	administration of:
33	(i) Title 26, Chapter 21, Health Care Facility Licensing and Inspection Act;
34	(ii) Title 26, Chapter 39, Utah Child Care Licensing Act; and
35	(iii) Title 62A, Chapter 2, Licensure of Programs and Facilities;
36	(b) money appropriated or otherwise made available by the Legislature; and
37	(c) any interest earned on the fund.
38	(2) Money in the fund may only be used by the department:
39	(a) for upgrades to and maintenance of licensing databases and applications;
40	(b) for training for providers and staff;

42	(d) for administrative expenses, if the administrative expenses for the fiscal year do not

47	(1) As used in this section, "fund" means the Division of Services for People with

49	(2) There is created in the General Fund an expendable special revenue fund known as
50	the "Division of Services for People with Disabilities Expendable Special Revenue Fund."
51	(3) The fund consists of carry forward funds from the division's budget.
52	(4) The Department of Health and Human Services may expend funds from the fund to
53	serve individuals eligible for division services statewide.
