Section 1. Section 67-16-11 is amended to read:	
67-16-11. Applicability of provisions.	
(1) As used in this section, "government position" means the position of a legislator,	
public officer, or public employee.	
(2) The provisions of this chapter:	
(a) apply to all public officers and public employees[-]; and

- 31 positions held by the same individual, unless the conflict of interest is also due to a personal
