AMENDS:

78A-1-104, as last amended by Laws of Utah 2022, Chapter 271

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the state of Utah:

Section 1. Section **78A-1-104** is amended to read:

78A-1-104. Number of juvenile judges.

The number of juvenile court judges shall be:

- (1) two juvenile judges in the First Juvenile District;
- (2) six juvenile judges in the Second Juvenile District;
- (3) nine juvenile judges in the Third Juvenile District;
- (4) [~~five~~] six juvenile judges in the Fourth Juvenile District;
- (5) three juvenile judges in the Fifth Juvenile District;

- 30 (6) two juvenile judges in the Sixth Juvenile District;
- 31 (7) two juvenile judges in the Seventh Juvenile District; and
- 32 (8) two juvenile judges in the Eighth Juvenile District.
