experience requirement for participation in an alternative preparation program.

28 Section 1. Section **53A-6-113** is enacted to read: 29 53A-6-113. Distance learning -- License requirements. (1) As used in this section, "distance learning" means instruction of curriculum that is: 30 31 (a) aligned with the core curriculum standards established by the board; and 32 (b) delivered from a remote location across state lines. 33 (2) A teacher who provides distance learning to a student in Utah is not required to 34 hold a license if: 35 (a) the teacher holds a teaching credential issued by another state for the grade level 36 and subject taught to a Utah student; 37 (b) the teacher is employed at a school in the state where the teacher's teaching 38 credential was issued; and 39 (c) the out-of-state school where the teacher is employed is accredited by the 40 accrediting body that accredits public schools in Utah pursuant to board rule. 41 Section 2. Section **53A-6-114** is enacted to read: 42 53A-6-114. Alternative preparation program -- Work experience requirement. An individual who is employed at least half time in a position for which a teacher's 43 license is required pursuant to board rule, including a position in an online school or a school 44 45 that uses digital technologies for instruction or blended learning, satisfies the work experience requirement for participation in an alternative preparation program. 46
