29	Be it enacted by the Legislature of the state of Utah:
30	Section 1. Repealer.
31	This bill repeals:
32	Section 71-11-11, Veterans' Nursing Home Reimbursement Restricted Account.
33	Section 2. Appropriation.
34	The Legislature has reviewed the following expendable special revenue fund. The
35	Legislature authorizes the State Division of Finance to transfer amounts among the account and
36	fund as indicated for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2013 and ending June 30, 2014. Outlays
37	and expenditures from the recipient fund may be made without further legislative action
38	according to a fund's applicable authorizing statute.

49	constitutional time limit of Utah Constitution, Article VII, Section 8, without the governor's
50	signature, or in the case of a veto, the date of veto override.
