6	A BILL to amend the Code of Virginia by adding a section numbered 55.1-1209.1, relating to the Virginia

9	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:
10	1. That the Code of Virginia is amended by adding a section numbered 55.1-1209.1 as follows:
11	§ 55.1-1209.1. Employees of the landlord; rental dwelling unit keys and electronic key codes;
12	policies and procedures.
13	A. As used in this section, "key" means any physical or electronic mechanism used to gain access
14	to a rental dwelling unit.
15	B. Any landlord who owns (i) more than four rental dwelling units in the Commonwealth or (ii)
16	more than a 10 percent interest, either individually or through a business entity, in more than four rental
17	dwelling units in the Commonwealth shall establish:
18	1. A policy requiring any applicant for employment in any position that will have access to keys
19	for each rental dwelling unit to be subject to a pre-employment criminal history records check; and
20	2. Written policies and procedures regarding the (i) storage, issuance and return, and security of;
21	(ii) access to; and (iii) if applicable, usage and deactivation of rental dwelling unit keys and electronic key
22	codes.
23	C. The provisions of this section shall not apply to (i) a financial institution, as defined in § 6.2-
24	100, or (ii) any person who is a real estate licensee pursuant to Chapter 21 (§ 54.1-2100 et seq.) of Title
25	<u>54.1.</u>
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
