**3. Committee:** Passed both houses.

**4. Title:** Motor Vehicle Dealer Board; examination costs.

**5. Summary:** Authorizes the Motor Vehicle Dealer Board to establish the cost of an examination of licensee records, which existing law requires the licensee to pay if such examination shows a violation of law or order of the Board. The bill removes the authority of the Board to recover such costs in a court of competent jurisdiction and provides that failure to pay such examination costs may be grounds for denying, suspending, or revoking a license or certificate of dealer registration or qualification.

**8. Fiscal Implications:** The Motor Vehicle Dealer Board sees no significant administrative costs associated with implementation of this legislation. The revenue impact depends on the cost of the examination and the number of violations. The revenue generated will be used for the expenses of the Motor Vehicle Dealer Board.
